

HOW TO WIN PRIZES

Each child registered for the Summer Reading Program will receive a “Build a Better World” ID badge. Each time they visit the library (for a program, to read, or check out books) children may get their card stamped at the Children’s Room desk (*one stamp per day, per person*). After 10 visits, kids will win a prize bag that includes a book, food coupons and some other fun surprises.

NO LIBRARY CARD? NO PROBLEM!

Because we’re not counting books read, kids can participate in ALL the summer fun AND win prizes, even if they don’t have a library card. However, it’s easy to sign your child up for one. Stop by the library any time for more details! (*Library card must be registered by the child’s parent or legal guardian. Parent’s valid photo ID and proof of address are required.*)

Specific details of all programs and activities will be announced as we get closer to summer. Sessions will regularly feature hands-on projects, science experiments, stories, games, crafts, outdoor exploration, special speakers and more. Kids will also have opportunities to win other prizes with reading challenges and other activities.
