WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

The Summer Reading Program at Hoopston Public Library is **FREE** and open to all children from age 3 through 5th grade (just finished). Kids **DO NOT** need a library card to attend. You do need a card to check out books. Parents, ask how to sign your child up!

Programs for **PRESCHOOL** (age 3-5 who have not yet attended Kindergarten) will be held at 10:30 a.m. on Fridays.

Programs for **GRADES K-5** will be held at 2 p.m. on Thursdays.

ALL AGES are invited to attend the Kickoff Movie "A Wrinkle in Time" on June 11. The Closing Carnival on July 12 is open to all kids who have filled their punch card with 10 visits to the library.

HOW TO REGISTER

Registration begins online and at the library on **Monday, May 14**. Children must be signed up by a **PARENT** or other adult caregiver. Kids will receive a punch card and a reading log to help track their summer reading progress and win prizes!
